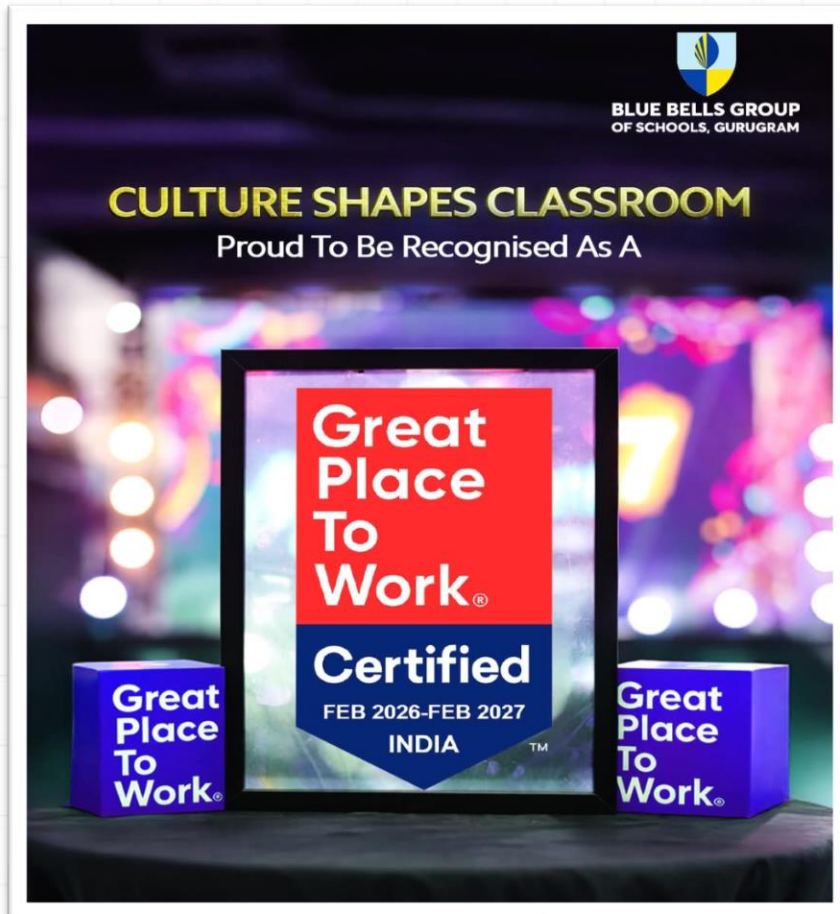

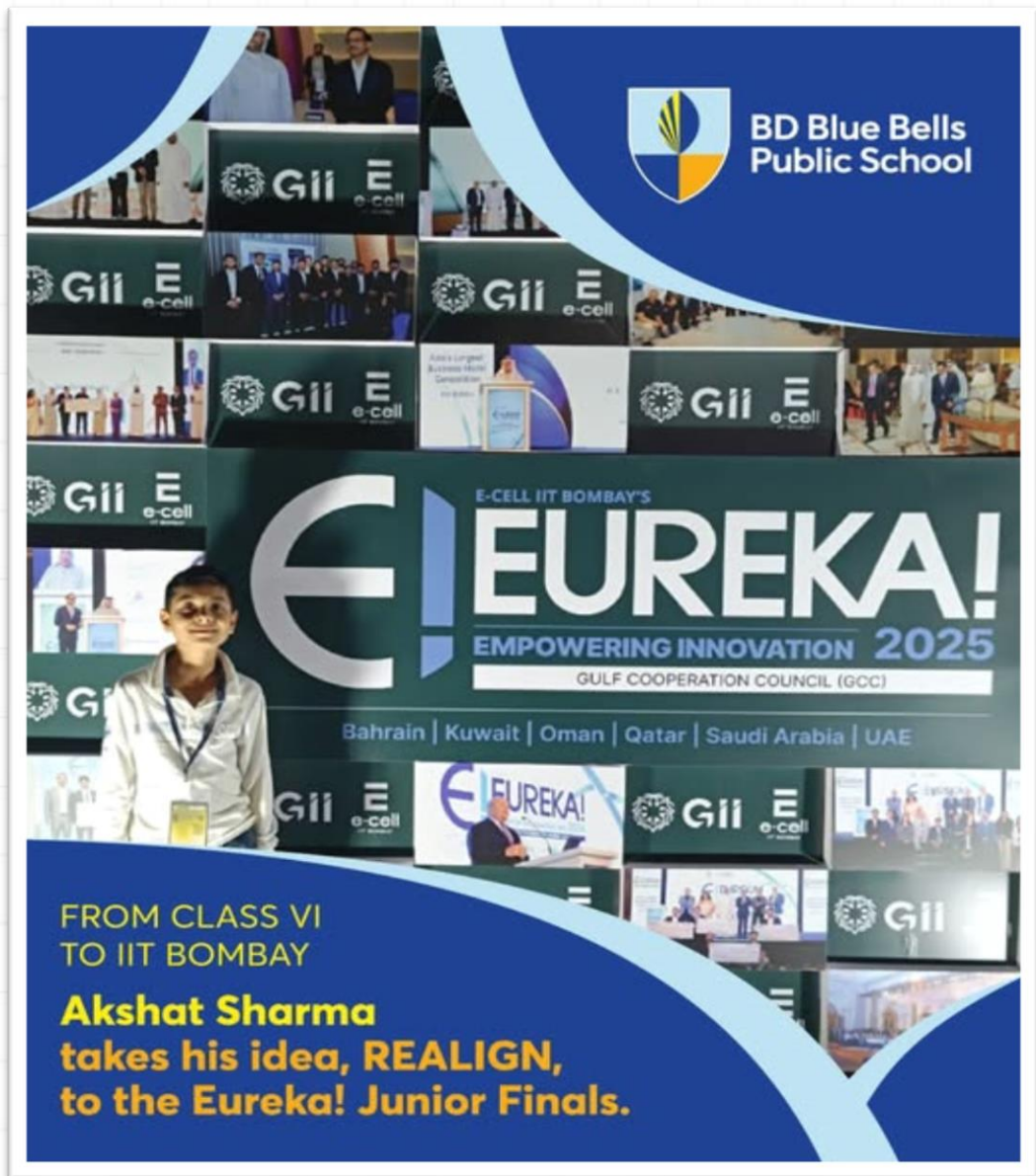

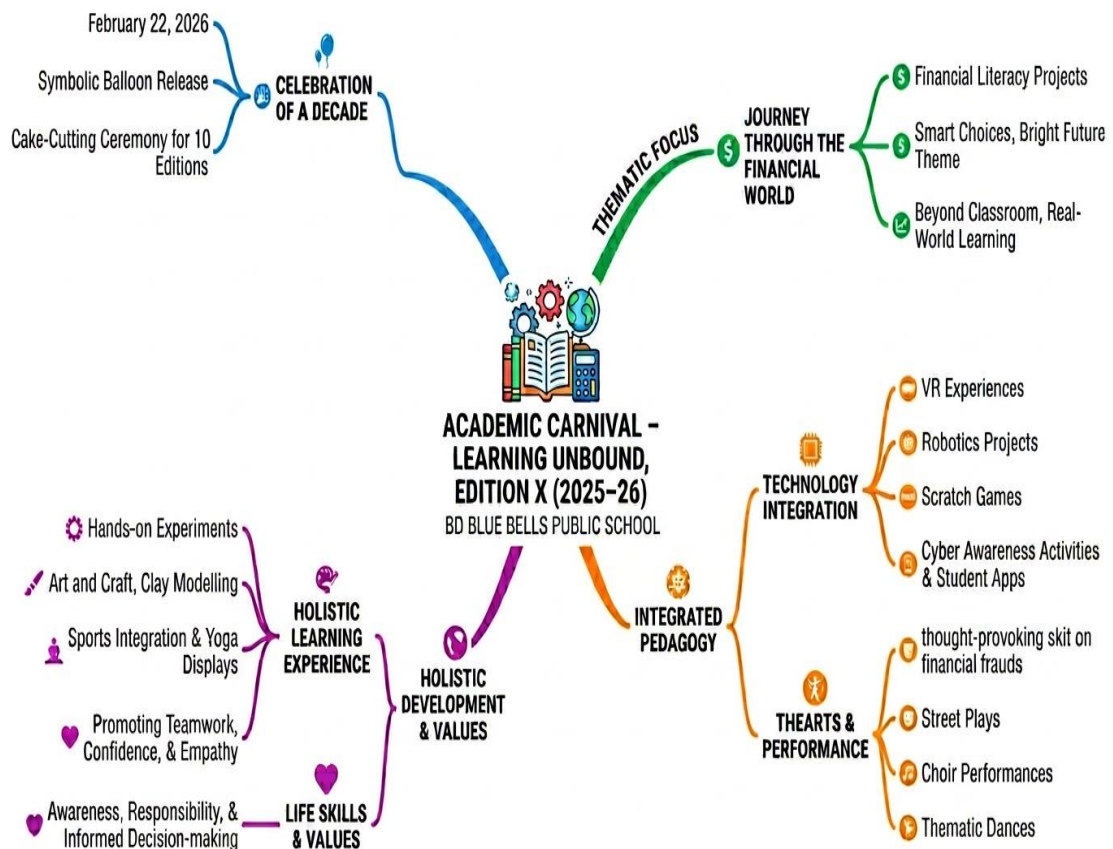
Learning Unbound – Edition X: A Decade of Inspiring Young Minds

Through engaging awareness drives, experiential workshops, and mindfulness practices, the Health & Wellness Team cultivates self-awareness, positivity, and emotional resilience. The initiative reflects a deeper educational philosophy—one that goes beyond academic achievement to shape character, build inner strength, and prepare individuals to navigate life with confidence, empathy, and purpose.

EVENTS ORGANIZED UNDER THE HEALTH & WELLNESS PROGRAMME

DISTRESS TO DE-STRESS: HANDLING EXAMINATION STRESS

During the examination period, emotional balance and mental calm are essential for students to perform with clarity and resilience. Recognising this need, the Health & Wellness Resource Centre team implemented a structured and engaging session on handling Examination Stress for senior school students.

Trained Life Skills Facilitators, conducted interactive sessions at BD Blue Bells Public School for Grades X and XII on December 10 and 11, 2025, followed by sessions for Grade IX on January 21, 2026, and Grade XI on January 22, 2026. These sessions aimed to equip students with practical tools to manage examination-related stress and enhance overall well-being.

Students were guided to recognise symptoms of stress, identify personal stress triggers, and understand factors influencing academic performance. The sessions also focused on reframing negative thoughts, effective time management through SMART study plans, and overcoming challenges such as procrastination, excessive phone use, and poor planning. Discussions on learning styles helped students adopt strategies aligned with their strengths. The importance of a healthy lifestyle, which includes a balanced diet, regular exercises and good sleeping habits, was also emphasized upon.

Relaxation techniques, including concentration exercises, progressive muscular relaxation, and guided imagery, were well received. The session reinforced the importance of a balanced approach to education and contributed significantly to fostering confidence, and lifelong life-skills among students.



FROM STRESS TO STRENGTH: EMPOWERING STUDENTS TO FACE EXAMS WITH CONFIDENCE: NURTURING EMOTIONAL RESILIENCE DURING EXAMINATIONS

Cultivating a calm, focused, and resilient mindset is essential for students as they navigate the academic and emotional demands of examinations. With this objective at heart, the 'Distress to De-Stress: Handling Examination Stress' module is conducted annually for Middle Wing students (Grades VI–VIII) . The module equips learners with practical, age-appropriate strategies to manage exam pressure, regulate emotions, and build inner strength.

The interactive sessions created a safe and encouraging space where students could openly reflect on their fears, challenges, and expectations around the exam time. The programme sensitively addressed common stress signals, tendencies towards procrastination, and exam-related anxieties, while reinforcing the importance of effective time management through the creation of SMART, realistic study schedules. Students were introduced to simple yet powerful productivity tools and actively engaged in concentration-building activities, relaxation practices, and guided imagery exercises that helped calm anxious minds and sharpen focus.

'A PARENTS' GUIDE TO NURTURING CAREER ASPIRATIONS'

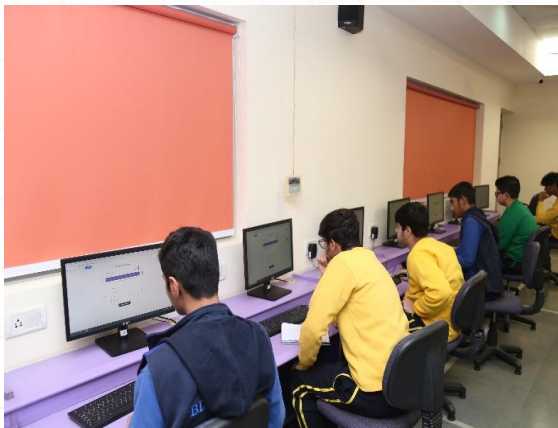
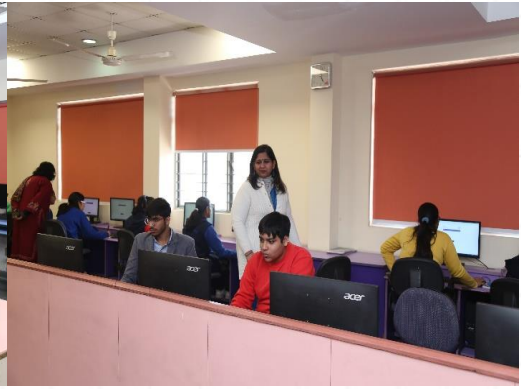
