


ORGANIZED UNDER THE HEALTH & WELLNESS PROGRAMME

ADVANCED TEACHER TRAINING PROGRAMME CATEGORY1-'EMPOWERING SELF' RECAP SESSION



Advance Teacher Training Programme is an in-service training programme formulated by the Health & Wellness Resource Center Team under the inspirational guidance of Dr. Alka Saxena, Deputy Director (Health & Wellness), BBGS. The first category (Empowering Self) a 4-day programme was conducted from 30th March to 2nd April 2021 for the teachers and staff of BBGS.



ADVANCED TEACHER TRAINING PROGRAMME, CATEGORY 2- 'UNDERSTANDING DEVELOPMENTAL NEEDS'









Advance Teacher Training Programme is an in-service training programme initiated and formulated by the Health &Wellness Resource Centre Team. The prime purpose of this in-service training is to enable teachers & staff to develop additional understanding and acquire innovative techniques which will further enable them to develop effectiveness in all spheres.

ATTP Category 2 "Understanding Developmental Needs" was designed as a weekly programme (every Thursday) from 12th August to 23rd September 2021 for the Pre-Primary teachers of BBGS. A group of 31 enthusiastic and lively members participated in this programme.

The main objective of this 7-week programme was to help teachers identify the developmental

The main objective of this 7-week programme was to help teachers identify the developmental milestones of children in the age group of 3-5 years and enhance the four developmental domains in them (Socio-Emotional, Language, Cognitive and Physical).






KINDNESS MATTERS CAMPAIGN


