





Dear Readers,

The focus of education should not be on suppressive information but on kindling the thirst for knowledge. As the Leader of an educational institution, I strongly feel that human life is enriched by the diversity of values and attitudes arising from different cultural perspectives and personality traits but there are some human values like respect for life and human dignity, and respect for the environment that cannot be compromised. The students of tomorrow will need to engage with the natural world, to appreciate its fragility, complexity and value. It is in sync with this perspective that NEP is stressing on mapping the curriculum with the SDG goals so that new wave pedagogies are introduced. **Dear Readers** 



This is facilitated through various sessions such as microteaching, lesson planning, and activity-based learning, which have been expanded to encompass all grades. The aim is to upskill educators and bolster their essential competencies, enabling them to effectively meet the constantly evolving needs of students. Blue Bells

#### INTRODUCTION TO LESSON PLAN TEMPLATE & FOLLOW-UP SESSIONS

The Learning & Development Centre, guided by Ms. Soumya Gulati, Deputy Director of Academic Development and Innovation at Blue Bells Group of Schools, organized a two-day session on Lesson Planning. The sessions were conducted on May 24th and May 26th, 2023, catering to teachers of Grades III-V, followed by sessions for teachers of Grades VI-VIII on May 25th and May 27th, 2024.

During the sessions, detailed discussions were held on the lesson plan template and the levels of Bloom's Taxonomy. Teachers were briefed on Constructivism in Learning, emphasizing Inquiry, Exploration, Questioning, Debate, Application, and Reflection, fostering meaningful understanding, concept attainment, and the generation of new ideas. Through various interactive activities, teachers effectively demonstrated their comprehension of the different levels of Bloom's Taxonomy.

For the subsequent session, teachers were tasked with preparing a Lesson Plan on a topic of their choice. In the following session, held the next day, teachers reviewed the previously prepared lesson plans in accordance with Bloom's Taxonomy. Discussions encompassed subject-specific skills, methodology, Bloom's levels in planned activities, a transdisciplinary approach, assessment of understanding, and closure activities, all tailored to the respective grade levels.



#### LEARNING EXPERIENCES

Over the past two decades, significant transformations have occurred in the perception and execution of teaching and learning methodologies within the education sector. To delve into these evolving paradigms and discuss the corresponding recommendations of the New Education Policy (NEP), The Learning Space organised sessions led by Ms. Kalpana Kapoor, on 29 May 2023 and 1 June 20223 for the Primary Wing and Middle Wing teachers respectively. Ms Kapoor, is the Former Principal, Delhi Public School Ghaziabad and a National Resource Person.

The objective of these sessions was to gain insights into the learning patterns of 21st-century students and equip educators with innovative strategies and methodologies for the teaching-learning process. Emphasis was placed on fostering joyful learning experiences for students, nurturing positive attitudes through non-competitive games, and fostering the development of knowledge, skills, and attitudes.

Teachers were introduced to student-centric transactional approaches aimed at the holistic development of 21st-century learners, navigating the VUCA (Volatility, Uncertainty, Complexity, Ambiguity) world, and frameworks such as Bloom's Taxonomy, Webb's Depth of Knowledge, The Maastricht 7-Jump Process, Kolb's Experiential Learning Model, Introductory activities for classes, De Bono's Six Thinking Hats, the Frayer Model, and effective questioning techniques. Throughout the session, teachers actively engaged in innovative and productive tasks and were encouraged to share their presentations as well.





#### MICRO TEACHING & OTHER TRAINING SESSIONS

Led by the inspiring guidance of Ms. Soumya Gulati, the In-house Learning Space Team organizes microteaching sessions and other training workshops aimed at annual subject planning. These sessions also facilitate discussions on classroom teaching strategies designed to transform learning into an enjoyable and engaging process.








## TRANSFORMING LEARNING LANDSCAPES NATIONWIDE




### EARTH DAY ASSEMBLY





The strength, wisdom, and love that the mothers personify was clearly evident in the way they participated in all the activities curated for them to make their day a super special one.








A mime was presented to discuss the real meaning of friendship. The mime gave the message of what it is like to be someone's friend and understand the bond that two friends share followed by a dance performance.

# INTERNATIONAL DAY OF CONSCIENCE





#### 25th October, 2023




Our students noted it carefully that Keshav Bhawan, the monsoon pavilion, is a single-storeyed baradari placed on an octagonal base, which stands tall and strong next to the Rup Sagar tank. The edifice has five arches along each side which seem to divide it into parts. An arcade runs around the interior of the pavilion over a canal with hundreds of fountains. The walls of the canal are pierced with hundreds of minute water jets. In the olden days bullocks were employed with large leather "buckets" to draw water to the tank through a complex pulley system.

All in all, it was really a great learning experience for the students which was equally appreciated by the parents and the students.


In the U-11 Girls category, Manvi of Class VI exhibited remarkable sportsmanship and clinched the Second Position.




















# ANKIT CHAUHAN FROM THE CLASS OF 2017 CRACKS UPSC IN FIRST ATTEMPT

#### LES ORIGINES DE L'ART FRANÇAIS

Les origines de l'art français ont été très influencés par l'art flamand et par l'art italien à l'époque de la Renaissance. Jean Fouquet, le plus célèbre peintre français médiéval, dit avoir été le premier à se rendre en Italie, tels que Primatice et Rosso Fiorentino, qui ont tous deux travaillé en France. Deux des plus célèbres artistes français de Claude Lorrain vivaient en Italie. Le 17ème siècle a été la période où la peinture et de sculpture est devenue importante et s'individualisa par le classicisme. Le Premier Ministre de Louis XIV, Jean-Baptiste Colbert, fonda en 1648 l'Académie Royale de peinture et de sculpture pour protéger ces artistes. Il créa en 1666 française encore en activité à Rome pour avoir des relations directes avec les artistes italiens. Les artistes françaises ont développé le style rococo dans le 18ème siècle, comme imitation plus intime de l'ancien style baroque, les œuvres des artistes judiciaires Antoine Watteau, François Boucher et Jean-Honoré Fragonard étant la plus représentative dans le pays. La Révolution française a apporté de grands changements, que Napoléon a favorisé, des artistes de style néoclassique, comme Jacques-Louis David et la très influente Académie des Beaux-Arts défini de style connu comme Académique.


