WORKSHOPS BY THE HEALTH & WELLNESS RESOURCE CENTER

SESSION FOR MOTHERS ON ART OF POSITIVE PARENTING

As a part of Health & Wellness Programme, an interactive session on "The Art of Positive Parenting" was organized and conducted by Health & Wellness Resource Center Team on May 5, 2018 to mark the occasion of Mother's Day Celebration. Dr. Alka Saxena explained to the mothers, that children do as they see and not as they hear. She shared that while communicating, it is important to ask instead of telling as it encourages one to search for answers. Ma'am further talked about the importance of empowering children as this helps them to be self-sufficient and provides them with confidence. Ma'am briefed about the importance of Setting Routine as this empowers children to be cooperative and motivated. It was rejuvenating to watch the mothers taking active part in the interactive discussions and activities which were the part of this invigorating workshop.



GOAL SETTING WORKSHOP FOR CLASS XII



Interactive session was conducted for Class XII on April 12, 2018 and the theme for the session was Setting Goals And Managing Time in Summer Vacations. After regular interactions with the students, it was felt that the students of Class XII will benefit from goal setting as during the vacations, the students have lot of unstructured time for themselves and sometimes they do not know how to utilize that time to the optimum. Hence, the need was felt to acquaint the students to understand the importance of setting goals for summer vacation so that they can plan during the vacation along with their studies. This will further result in enhancing their knowledge along with following their passion. In the session facilitator focused on importance of the goal setting, how we can set SMART goals, and always set your own goals for yourself. Goals are about what you want to do, rather than not want to do. The facilitator also briefed about time wasters and how time can be managed effectively and also focus on time management. The students

were also apprised about how they can increase their productivity by using some tips like: - always planning the day in advance, consolidating similar tasks together, learning to say no when they are busy etc. The students were also advised about healthy life style which would help them gain physical fitness and mental alertness.

STUDY SKILLS FOR CLASS XI

The theme for this module emerged due to some concerns that were shared by the students on the change they witnessed from Class X's CCE pattern to Class XI's studies that appeared humongous for them and lead to stress. This was the resultant of the change in the course structure, study time and the way of studying. In sync with the same, an ardent need was felt by Dr. Alka Saxena, Deputy Director (Health & Wellness), BBGS and the Resource Center team to take this theme with the students of class XI so that they can be comforted and also help them feel more prepared to deal with the changes around. The interactive session was taken by the school Counsellors on May 18, 2018 which witnessed the enthusiastic participation of the students. As Class XI forms a solid foundation for Class XII, therefore, the beginning of new academic session was the most appropriate time to discuss certain important study skills which the students can use to plan, study and prepare themselves throughout the year. The key points



discussed in the sessions with the students were about the changes and how they were feeling about them. The PQRST (Preview, Question, Read, Self-study and Test) technique of studying was discussed in detail wherein the students were told about the importance of studying in a systematic manner to retain information. Some points about organizing themselves were shared with them. Besides that some hands on tips on note taking, note making, academic reading skills, and writing skills were shared with them. A befitting close to the session was the discussion on the importance of a study friendly environment where prominence was given on understanding their pattern of studying and focusing on their learning styles.
