Creativity involves stepping into the realm of imagination on a flight of fancy and an act of aesthetic creation is not only a product of toil, sweat and tears, but is also born out of an intense desire to give concrete shape to one's dream. To provide this unique platform of innovation, exploration and experimentation, the students of the school participated in the Design Championship for Industrial Designing at Modern School, Barakhamba Road, New Delhi on August 27, 2016. The First phase of the competition was to prepare a Project Report of an industrial design of a product with minimum expenditure and maximum dividends. The students perceived the idea of a cooling system that would be easily set up in the rural area of the country and can be easily afforded by the poor strata of society so that the wastage of food is minimal. The working of the model required the material available at home and harnessing energy through natural resources. They devised an action plan and prepared a soft copy of the design and named their product – 'du Froid – An Ultimate Cooling Refrigerator'. The students of Class X.—Daksh Shamma, Kartikey Gulia and Anish Sawant cleared the First Round and were called for the

Finals in New Delhi. There they not only gave a tough competition to the students of the top notch schools of Delhi & NCR but proved their excellence and mettle by clinching the First Position in the Competition. They brought laurels for the alma mater reaffirming its top position as the vanguard in almost all paraphernalia of what is best in education.

#### MISSION STOP DENGUE: AN AWARENESS CAMPAIGN BY EMINENT DOCTORS

Education is a powerful tool through which we can enlighten the young impressionable minds to become an asset for the nation. It has been rightly said that if you want your child to shine like a star, don't show the other stars but the way to reach the sky. Education is an endless journey through knowledge and enlightenment. To bring in awareness amongst the students to fight against Dengue fever and other communicable diseases, The Health and Wellness Programme of the school spearheaded by Dr. Alka Saxena, Assistant Director (Health and Wellness), BBGS organized An Awareness Campaign by eminent doctors from the department of Internal Medicine, Medanta, The Medicity, Gurgaon on August 17, 2016. This was an effort to sensitize the student community on the spread of the disease as well as its prevention and early diagnosis. The doctors briefed the students about the symptoms of the disease and how it is caused. Dengue fever, also known as breakbone fever, is an acute communicable disease caused by virus transmitted by the Aedes mosquito. The students were also apprised of the breeding condition of the mosquitoes and What can be done to reduce the risk of acquiring dengue. Dengue prevention techniques were shared like -Mosquito Control and Protection against bites and in case of emergency reporting to the doctor. The sessions were interactive and students shared their concerns with the experts. The doctors also shared the ways in which we can have healthy habits in our life style to prevent the spread of various vector borne diseases. In the last session of the Lecture, a Quiz was conducted to check the understanding of the students about the disease and the response of the students was overwhelming. The students





answered all the questions and the team of doctors applauded the efforts of the students and also shared that some answers given by the students were so unique that they were spellbound by the intelligence and awareness they had about the disease. Team. The detailed information about the disease was also displayed at the strategic locations in the school as well as Health Advisory was uploaded on the school website so that each and every member of the school can be sensitized on the same.
