#### INDUSTRIAL DESIGN CHAMPIONSHIP

The School team comprising of Dhruv Punia, Bhuwan Mohan, Karunesh Yadav and Arjun Singh clinched the coveted Second Position in Industrial Design Category in Design Championship organized by Mindbox at Shiv Nadar School, Noida on August 24, 2018. Adding more feathers to this cap of glory, in the Graphic Design Category, the students, Gaurav Marwah, Namo Jain and Lakshay Tyagi bagged the Second Position. In the Industrial Design Category, the students designed a water cistern to be attached to the tap which would control the wastage of water and also the water collected would be used for generation of electricity. They complimented their presentation with the 3D Model. In the Graphic Design, the students designed a Logo for their Gaming Company and brought laurels for the alma mater. The students used all the latest tools for making their Logo attractive and appealing. The event saw the enthusiastic participation of 90 renowned schools of Delhi & NCR (Khaitan, DPS, DAV, Shiv Nadar, G.D. Goenka, Modern School and Maharaj Agrasen etc.) and the level of the competition was high. Around 630 projects were a part of the competition. The judges were thoroughly mesmerized by the innovative presentation of our students with 3D Model and heartily lauded their efforts.

## TINKERFEST 2018

TinkerFest was aimed at encouraging innovation among students, teaching them about product prototypes and developing problem solving and entrepreneurial skills. Students were trained hands - on in ideation methods, mechanical design and fabrication, microprocessor programming, basic electronics and presentation skills. As the school has the first functional Hi-Tech ATL Lab in Gurugram, the





students were provided a platform to explore, innovate & experiment with latest tech tools. Thirty students participated in the fest and transformed their ideas into working projects. Participants developed projects like Air Ink, a device which converts carbon present in the air to an ink which can be used for writing. They showcased their projects on improving the Rain Water Harvesting System and developed an Automatic Irrigation System, that senses moisture in the soil and waters the plants accordingly.
