WORKSHOP ON HEALTH, WELLNESS & HYGIENE PROGRAM FOR GIRLS

Our younger generation needs to be prepared with the abilities to think critically and to create genuinely, and to communicate and cooperate effectively with people from different backgrounds and cultures. The school aims at inculcating in the students the values which are most relevant in today's world. The Health, Wellness & Value Education Programme of the school helps the young generation by adding strength to their natural abilities which inculcates the habit team work and increases their productivity. Under the able guidance of Dr. Alka Saxena, Assistant Director (Health & Wellness), BBGS, the school organised a Workshop on "Health, Wellness & Hygiene of GIRLS" on September 23, 2016. The session was conducted by Ms. Isha Malhotra from Procter & Gamble. This was one of the initiatives of the programme to empower the young girls about the importance of hygiene in their growing years. After a brief introduction, Ms. Isha introduced the topic "Health & Hygiene for Girls" to the students of Classes V, VI and VII. She asked the students to share their experience regarding the same. A video was then shown which depicted the talk between two girls and the problems faced in the daily routines during the menstrual phase. The other symptoms of onset of puberty like: mood swings, etc were also discussed. The general queries of the students were also answered.

The following information was shared:

- The onset of puberty starts at the age between 9-13 yrs
- We must have a healthy diet
- We must maintain a personal hygiene
- Mild exercises should be done
- Hot water bath/ fermentation can help easing the cramps.
- Advantages of using sanitary pads over cloth pads.

The Workshop closed with the distribution of a sample of "Whisper" & "a booklet" that consisted of the details of the topic. The summing up of the topic was done by Ms. Shreya Kumar & Ms. Komal Chugh. It was a great learning experience for the students.



A PIONEERING INITIATIVE: SAFE DIWALI MODULE BY THE HEALTH & WELLNESS TEAM



Deepavali ("Array of Lights") is a festival primarily of light. Diwali celebrates the dispelling of all that is symbolized by darkness. The traditional celebration, therefore, consisted of the aesthetic and lavish arraying of lights against the darkness of the night. When commercial firecrackers and fireworks became popular in the last century, the emphasis in our celebration of Diwali seems almost to have shifted from dazzling light to explosive sound. This was the thought that motivated the Resource Centre of The Health and Wellness Programme to prepare the module on Safe Diwali for the students. Dr. Alka Saxena, Assistant Director (Health and Wellness), BBGS along with her Resource Centre Team of school counsellors – Ms. Shreya Kumar and Ms. Renu Khare and Ms. Aarti (Executive Assistant) devised this module after thorough research with all the statistics and verifying data. The module was taken up for Classes III to X from October 12 to October 27, 2016, by the Health and Wellness teachers and Peer Educators in specific time slots so that the feeling and values could be internalized and everyone could be sensitized towards the issue.

In the Module, the students were apprised about 'How To Celebrate A Safe And Green Diwali' and covered the minutest details like :-

- The present way of celebrating Diwali and its harmful effects, (Supported by videos)
- Pollution and other environmental factors
- Harmful effects on humans during Diwali
- Harmful effects on animals during Diwali
- Wasteful expenditure
- Adulteration and over consumption of sweets
- Safety tips to follow during Diwali (Do's and Don'ts)

The sessions were interactive and good researched videos compelled the students to think beyond. Child Labour (Making Crackers), Happy and Safe Diwali for Pets, Adulteration and Purity of Diwali were some of the presentations that propelled all the students to review the situation in a different light. All the sessions were well supported by the Resource centre team. The students were urged by the team TO SAY NO TO CRACKERS as the crackers and pyrotechnics release more light and sound. Their dazzling aerial displays and explosions are accompanied by release of smoke and fine particles with lead, cadmium, magnesium, sodium, nitrates, nitrites and other substances which persist in the air and wash down into our drinking water and may harm the health. The careless handling of fireworks can cause injury to people and animals in their vicinity. For these and other reasons, the use of firecrackers in celebrations has been a source of concern the world over for a long time. It was an earnest attempt by the Health and Wellness Team to create sensitivity on the issue along with understanding the real essence of celebrating Diwali.

LITERATURE : A MIRROR OF LIFE IN COLLABORATION WITH WOYAMBA ROYAL COLLEGE , SRI LANKA



Literature is one of the most significant mediums through which our society can discover extraordinary things about ordinary people. To make the students understand the international cultural and social milieu, the students of Classes III and IV undertook the project 'Literature: A Mirror of life', during the third and fourth week of September. The aim of the project was to apprise the students with the social milieu of India, Sri Lanka and America through their Literature, folk tales, poems and short stories. As a part of an international collaboration for this project, with Woyamba Royal College, Sri Lanka, the students of both the schools exchanged their scripts to learn more about each other's culture. The videos of the presentations were shared between the schools. The students of Class IV also enacted famous Indian and American stories from Akbar and Birbal and extracts from Mark Twain's 'Adventures of Tom Sawyer' and Washington Irving's 'Rip Van Winkle' respectively. The students could learn about the differences in cultures through the stories. The students of Class III prepared a Class Magazine that included Comic Strips on Indian and American Stories, Work of prominent Writers, Letter to a Pen Friend, Picture Story, Word Maze and Self Composed Poems. In the process the students explored American and Indian Literature and became familiar with the prominent writers and their works.



GLOBAL WARMING : A GLOBAL WARNING- IN COLLABORATION WITH K2 METHODIST BASIC SCHOOL, GHANA, SOUTH AFRICA



The aim of the project was to collect, analyze and represent the data related to the estimated CO₂ emission in Russia, USA, China, Australia, Japan and India in the past 5 years (2010 - 2015). The school collaborated with K2 METHODIST BASIC SCHOOL, Ghana (South Africa). Skype sessions were there wherein students exchanged data and information. The students researched and examined the information on the estimated carbon dioxide emission in the last 5 years (2010 -2015) in the different countries. They organized the data collected by them in the form of a pictograph and bar graph for thorough investigation by comparing and contrasting. The students critically analyzed the effects of carbon dioxide emission on our planet and steps taken by different countries to reduce global warming. They shared their understanding of the concept with the students of via various Skype sessions. This gave a new dimension to the understanding of the students about the research on the level of pollution and concern of every country to combat the situation. At the end of the project the students were able to identify and interpret the collated data, to represent the collected data of CO₂ emission of these six countries in pictorial and graphical form and to understand the effect of CO₂ emission on the environment and appreciate the steps taken by different countries to reduce it. The understanding of the project was displayed during the Mathematics Exhibition organized as a part of GANIT Week Celebration in the school wherein the invited parents whole heartedly appreciated the efforts of the students and the school team.
