MESSAGE

"Children need encouragement just as plants need water. They cannot survive without it." - Dreikurs

No one can deny that discipline is vital to every living being and without it, the world around us would be in chaos. Discipline brings stability and structure into a person's life. It teaches a person to be responsible and respectful and promotes good interpersonal relationships. Discipline is crucial not only for adults but children too, as it is necessary for their happiness and well being and helps them to tackle the challenges of life.

However, the general perception is that discipline can be enforced only through punishment and coercive methods. In a way, the word 'Discipline' has come to be negatively associated with punishment. Coercive methods may get the desired results in short term but in the long term they are ineffective. Jane Nelsen, in her book 'Positive Discipline' states that using punishment leads to Four R's - Resentment, Revenge, Rebellion and Retreat, among children which has a negative impact on them.

On the other hand, people who do not believe in punishment or coercive methods become too permissive. However, this is not helpful either in raising self- motivated and self- disciplined children. In fact, permissiveness leads to feeling of entitlement and lack of kindness, empathy and responsibility. Neither is being permissive nor are coercive methods to discipline the children a desirable approach to nurture responsible children.

Over the past few years it has been observed that there is a marked difference in the behaviour of the children. With the change in structure of society, they have fewer opportunities necessary to learn responsibility. When children do not get the opportunity to contribute in meaningful ways, they do not feel a sense of belongingness or significance and do not develop responsibility. Teaching children self-discipline hence becomes



a challenge and the conflict between coercive methods and permissiveness continues. This means we need to rethink about discipline and adopt a Positive Discipline Approach which is based on mutual respect. The approach of Positive Discipline is based on the philosophy of Alfred Adler and Rudolph Dreikurs.

Jane Nelsen, in her book 'Positive Discipline' discusses that positive discipline is an approach that teaches important social and life skills in a manner that is respectful for both adults and children.

Positive Discipline focuses on connection before correction. It focuses on understanding misbehaviour and to respond to it in a proactive manner to reinforce positive behaviour.

Reinforcing positive discipline among children helps to empower them to be self-disciplined and self-motivated. It helps to inculcate a sense of belongingness and significance which results in more responsible, respectful adults.

SENSITIZING STUDENTS ON SAFETY: WORKSHOP ON SAFE TOUCH



The meaning of social interaction has changed with time. The volatile relationship paradigms require children to remain alert and updated on many issues; safety being a prominent one. Keeping in mind the necessity to sensitize students about keeping themselves safe, a module on safe touch was conducted in the months of October and November 2018. These sessions were taken with the students of Classes UKG to VIII by Value Education & Life Skills Education Facilitators in their respective Classes. The students were made aware of their body parts, especially their personal zones which are not to be seen or touched by anyone. The difference between safe & unsafe touches, adopting safety measures like - 'Say No', 'Scream', 'Run



for Help' & and 'Tell' a trusted adult (Like; Parents, Teachers & Counsellors) were also shared with them. Module also aimed at educating students on vulnerabilities and threats that exist around them. It was conducted to support the cause of creating awareness on child safety. The session was summarized by showing age appropriate videos to students on safety suggested by CBSE and Gurgaon Police. The session added a lot of understanding regarding maintaining safety. The students put forth a number of queries which were attended well by the team.

DISTRESS TO DE-STRESS: HANDLING EXAMINATION STRESS

During examinations, it is important for the students to be in a calm state of mind and to deal with any emotion which may be causing distress. To address the feelings and concerns of students and to help them manage their stress, an interactive module was conducted with the students. This session was taken by the Health & Wellness Resource Centre team for the students of Classes X, XI and XII in December 2018. The session

- Ways to identify stress
- Internal and external factors that lead to stress during examinations
- Identifying and dealing with automatic negative thoughts
- Managing time effectively through prioritizing and making SMART time table
- Being aware of obstacles to time management and how to handle it
- Tips to increase productivity
- Identifying and incorporating learning styles
- Importance of a healthy lifestyle. Like, balanced diet, regular exercise, good sleeping habits, and harmful effects that simulating activities like television, phones, video games, arguments, etc. can have before sleeping.

Lastly, a few concentration exercises along with a short progressive muscular relaxation and guided imagery were conducted. These exercises help in feeling calm, relaxed and increase concentration span. The session concluded on a positive note where it was shared with the students that they could connect individually with the counsellors for any further support.


